Subject : AIRCRAFT INSURANCE CERTIFICATES

It has been detected from aircraft documents that some foreign aircraft operators have deliberately falsified or forged aircraft Certificates of Insurance to satisfy international oversight requirements.

UAE Civil Aviation Law Article 7, (6) states that an aircraft must be insured for the benefit of its crew, passengers and third party when operating in UAE territory or in the airspace above its territory. There are strict penalty provisions associated with this Article.

Operators of aircraft are encouraged to ensure that the aircraft copy of the Certificate of Insurance is valid, adequate and legal. Any aircraft found in the UAE without a valid Certificate of Insurance will be subjected to applicable provisions of UAE Civil Aviation Law.

All concerned parties are advised to take appropriate action in this regard.
